**EVERETT C. ALMEIDA JR.**

SOMERSET — Everett C. Almeida Jr., 66, of 393 Wood St., Somerset, well known in his youth as a soccer player, died Sunday at Charlton-Memorial Hospital in Fall River.

Husband of Belmira (Motta) Almeida, he was stricken with a stroke 12 years ago that forced his retirement as a painting contractor. He became ill at his home Sunday and was taken to the hospital.

Born in Fall River, son of the late Evaristo C. and Guilhermina (Cabral) Almeida, he lived in Somerset for the past 38 years. Before becoming a house painter, he was an agent for the Prudential Life Insurance Co. and a salesman for the Stafford Furniture Co. of Fall River.

He was a member of St. Patrick's Church in Somerset, the Portuguese Cultural Society, and the Fall River Stroke Club.

Survivors, in addition to his wife, are a son, Everett C. Almeida 3d of Dighton; a daughter, Elizabeth Ann of Somerset; a sister, Mrs. Ernest (Clofide) Mello of Swansea; and several nieces and nephews.
