### Daniel J. Amaral

WORCESTER, Mass. — Daniel J. Amaral, 36, of 39 May St., a former Seekonk resident who was a geography instructor at Clark University here, was pronounced dead Friday at Worcester City Hospital. He was the husband of Stacy (Dratfield) Amaral.



Born in Pawtucket, he was a son of Joseph M. and Mary (Silvia) Amaral, of Seekonk. He had lived in Worcester 18 years, as a student at Holy Cross College, a teacher in the public schools, a graduate student at Clark University and, since last year, a member of the faculty at Clark.

Mr. Amaral graduated with honors from East Providence High School in 1962 and was class valedictorian. He graduated from Holy Cross cum laude in 1966.

He was a Fulbright Scholar in Nicaragua and in 1968 established a center for Puerto Rican immigrants in Worcester under the Roman Catholic diocese.

Besides his wife and parents, he leaves a son, Aaron Amaral, and a daughter, Maria E. Amaral, both of Worcester; a brother, Paul T. Amaral of Swansea; a sister, Mrs. Evelyn Freeman of Baltimore, Md., and his grandparents, Mariano and Maria Amaral of Seekonk.

A funeral will be held tomorrow at 10 a.m. from the Rebello Funeral Home, 90½ Broadway, East Providence, with a Mass of Christian Burial in Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church, Seekonk, at 11 a.m.

Burial will be at Gate of Heaven Cemetery, East Providence.
