## THE DONNA HOLT SIEMIATOWSKI VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR AWARD

In 2001 the New England Genealogical Conference established the Siemiatowski Award for an individual who, in performing volunteer service to the NERGC or its member societies, best personifies the volunteer and creative service demonstrated by Donna Holt Siemiatowski. The award is for an individual who has provided outstanding volunteer service over and above that normally expected of their elected or appointed position. Nominations may be submitted by delegates from NERGC member societies, the society's president, NERGC officers or its Board of Directors. The nomination shall include the full name of the nominee, a short vitae, the name of the organization for which the outstanding volunteer services were performed and a descriptive one-page essay describing the qualifying services to the NERGC or to the member society and to the field of genealogy as a whole.

Donna Holt Siemiatowski was born in Hartford, Connecticut, on February, 16, 1946. She was a founder and first president of the Descendants of the Founders of Windsor and the first president of the Connecticut Professional Genealogical Council. For nearly twenty years she was virtually a permanent fixture in the Connecticut State Library's (CSL) History and Genealogy Unit. She was a member of Connecticut's Historical Records Advisory Board and represented the genealogical community on the CSL's Newspaper Advisory Board. Donna died on August 6, 2001, preceded in death on June 23 by.....

From the inception of the Society in 1977 to her death in 2001, Cecilia performed a myriad of tasks associated with her position. She handled the American-Portuguese Genealogical and Historical Society's world-wide correspondence and edited its quarterly newsletter, the *Bulletin Board*. She secured the Society's tax-exempt status and articles of incorporation, prepared the voluminous applications for grants, and enlisted volunteers to help with fundraisers. But going above and beyond her responsibilities, she initiated an annual genealogy workshop and worked diligently to introduce genealogy into the Taunton, Massachusetts Public Schools. Childless herself (she never married), the APGHS was her child.

**Nomination Paper for Cecilia Rose—submitted September 15, 2002**

From its inception in 1977 to her death twenty-four years later in 2001, Cecilia Marianne Rose was the American-Portuguese Genealogical and Historical Society. She nurtured it through three presidents and the loss of three of its founders. As its secretary, she did the Society's world-wide (Australia, Canada, Great Britain, New Zealand, Portugal, Sweden) correspondence and edited its quarterly newsletter, the *Bulletin Board*.

Others supplied information about available grants; she did the required voluminous writing. The Society's tax-exempt status and articles of incorporation were accomplished through her. The introduction of genealogy into Taunton schools and an annual genealogy workshop were her ideas. She enlisted volunteers to help with fundraisers, but her workload equaled three of them.

Childless herself (she never married), the APGHS, now an accepted member of the New England genealogical community, was her child.

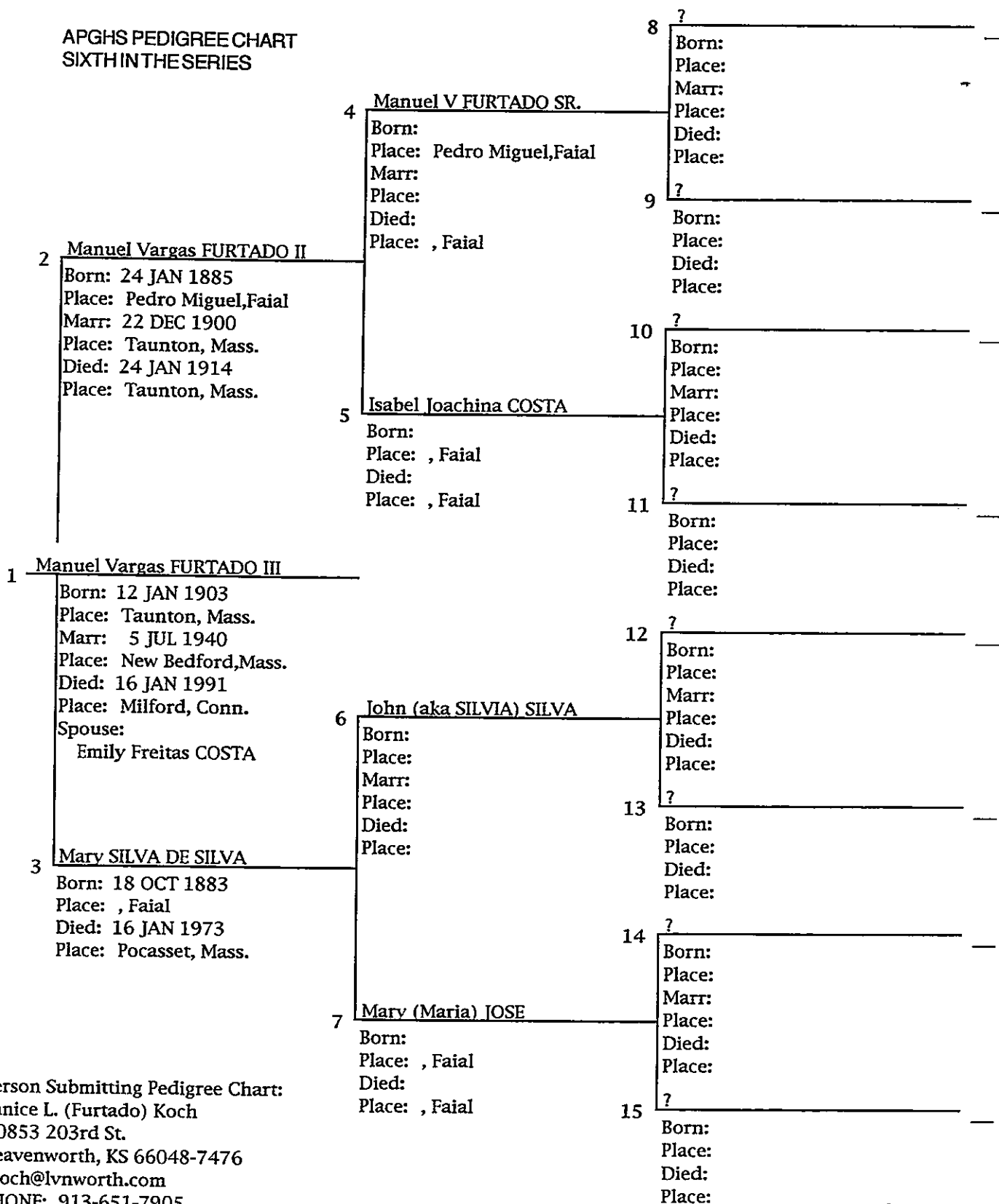

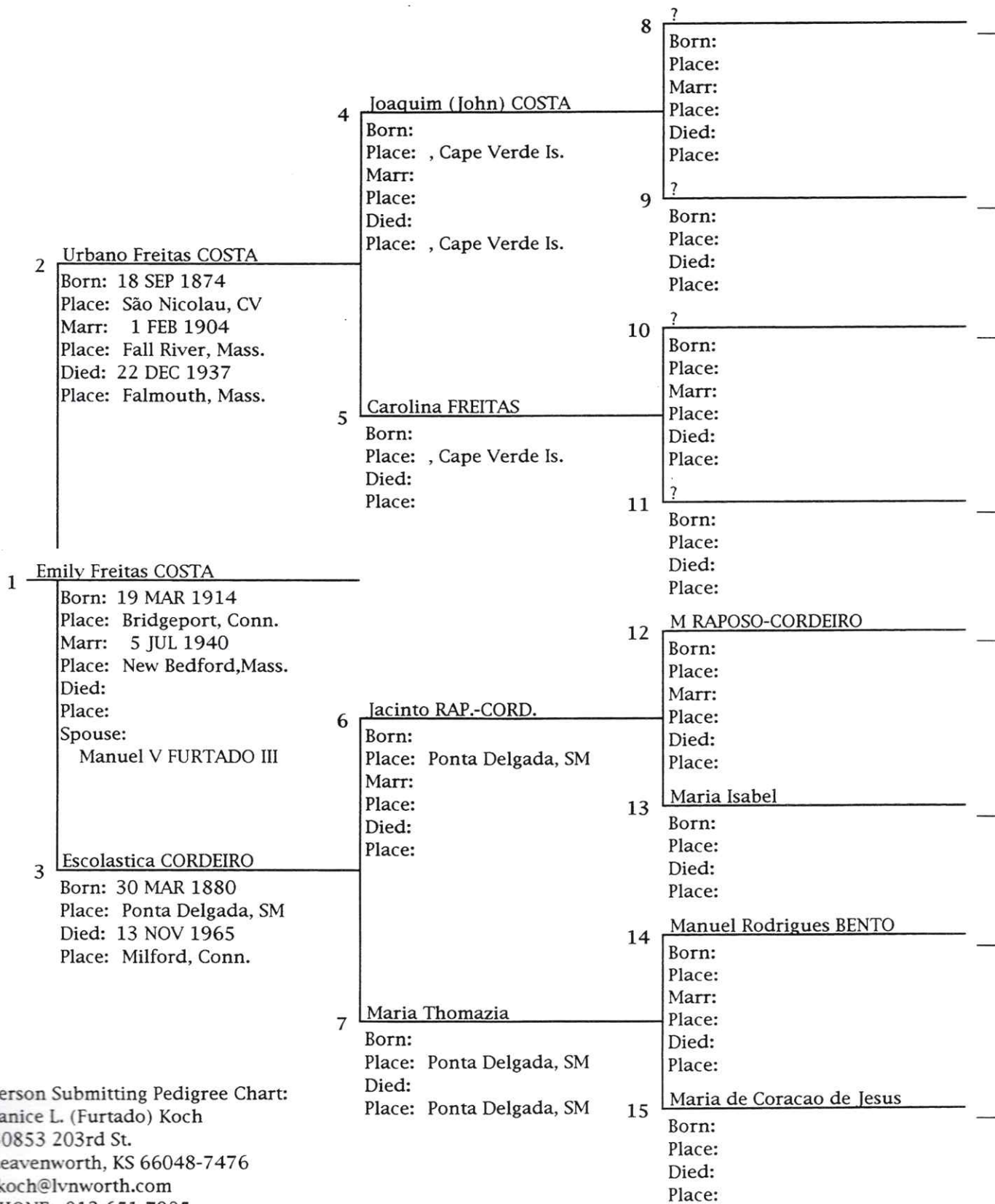

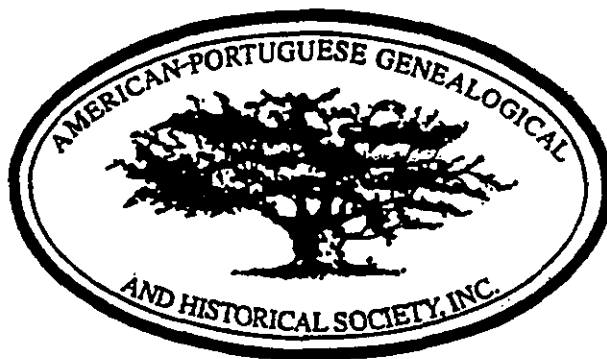
