

Frank Azevedo, nursing home trustee, dead

Trustee and former chairman of the Taunton Nursing Home board of trustees Frank Azevedo, 66, of 10 Church St., died Tuesday at home following a long illness. He was the husband of Sadie M. (Loretto) Azevedo.

Serving nearly a decade as a trustee for the nursing home, he was a former chairman of the Board of Public Welfare and of the Democratic City Committee and chairman of the Ward Three Democratic Committee.

He had worked as a driver for the former Staples Coal and Oil Co., retiring seven years ago. Born in Taunton, he was the son of the late Joaquim and Annie (Almeida) Azevedo.

He was graduated from Taunton High School in 1931 and was a communicant of St. Mary's Church.
