BLOOMFIELD, N.J. — Jose F. Conde, 56, of 55 Berkley Place, formerly of New Bedford, died yesterday after a long illness. He was the husband of Helen (Sylvia) Conde.

He died at the St. Barnabas Hospital in Livingston.

He was born in New Bedford, and lived there for many years. He had been a resident of Bloomfield for the past 20 years, and was a communicant of Sacred Heart Church in Bloomfield.
