Frank B. Correia, 78, of 91 Winthrop St., a banjo player with the former Harry Weygand Band who entertained throughout the Taunton area at local clubs and restaurants, died Monday night at Morton Hospital following a long illness.

Until a few months ago he had been performing at the Club 138, Stoughton, when he became ill.
