

Lovicy M. Delano

WAREHAM — Lovicy Mason Delano, 89, of Roland Thatcher Nursing Home, died yesterday at the home after a long illness.

She was born in Marion.

Miss Delano was a 1910 graduate of Tabor Academy and Wellesley College, class of 1915. She taught at Taunton High School five years and at Passaic High School in New Jersey 30 years as head of the German department until retiring in 1954.

She was a life member of the Marion United Methodist Church and a teacher of its adult class and the Southern New England Conference of United Methodist Women. She was chairman of the Methodist Conference summer school three years. She was a member of the Southeastern Massachusetts Wellesley Club and the Sippican Historical Society, of which she was first secretary.

Miss Delano was an honorary member of the Sippican Women's Club and a member of the Marion Ecumenical Council. She traveled extensively and lived in Germany in the early 1930s and in Zurich, Switzerland, in the late 1940s.
