**FALL RIVER** — Frank Ferry, 77, of 575 Sharp's Lot Road, Swansea, a retired truck driver active in local organizations, died yesterday at Charlton Memorial Hospital, Union site, after a brief illness. He was the husband of Josephine M. (Frado) Ferry.

Born in Tiverton, R.I., son of the late Manuel R. and Rose (Martin) Ferry, he had been a resident of Swansea for most of his life. He was a communicant of St. Patrick's Church, Somerset.

For 33 years, he was employed as a truck driver for the former Louis L. Drape Fish Market, Fall River. When the market closed, he worked for nine years for Schwartz Lumber Company, Fall River, until retiring 10 years ago.

He was a member of the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 526, and the Teamsters Retirees Club of Fall River.

He was a member of the Somerset Senior Citizens Friday Club and the American Association of Retired Persons, Swansea Chapter 1052. He was also a member of two bowling leagues, including the Seniors 10-Pin League and Harvey Prober League.
