George James Healey, 81, of 14 Cherry St., husband of Hortense "Carol" (Cabral) Healey, died at Morton Hospital Sunday morning after a long illness.

Born in Boston, he was a resident of Taunton for the past 75 years. He was the foster son of the late John and Margaret Dugan.

He was employed for many years in the maintenance department of the Mass. Department of Public Works at Bridgewater.

He served in the U.S. Navy as an apprentice seaman-electrician from 1911 to 1921.

He was a fish warden for Taunton for many years. He held the record for the largest white perch (3 pounds, 10 ounces) ever caught at Prospect Pond. He caught it in 1924.

He was a communicant of St. Anthony's Church.

Besides his wife, he leaves two sons, Paul A. Healey of Riverside, Calif. and Barry J. Healey of Berkley; one daughter, Mrs. Lawrence (Nina) Knox of Taunton; and six grandchildren.
