### ANTHONY S. LOPES

Anthony S. Lopes, a retired Taunton police officer, died suddenly this morning at Morton Hospital. He was the husband of Lee (Araujo) Lopes and was 63.

Lopes, who resided at 3 Highland Ave., joined the Taunton police force on July 9, 1940 as a reserve officer and was appointed a patrolman on Feb. 6, 1945. He retired from the force in October of 1966.

Born in Taunton and a lifelong resident of the city, he was the son of the late Manuel and Helen (Miranda) Lopes.

A member of the Taunton Police Mutual Benefit Association, he was a communicant of St. Joseph's Church.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Mrs. John J. (Linda) Bernardino of Taunton and two sons, Anthony G. of Boston and William J. of Taunton.

Also, he leaves three brothers, Justin, Manuel and John, all of Taunton, and two sisters, Mrs. Joseph (Lucy) Katon and Helen Hancock of Taunton.
