Former amateur boxer Antone A. "Tony" Medeiros, 72, of 8 Herbert St., died Monday night at Morton Hospital following a short illness. He was the husband of Mary B. (Bent) Medeiros.

He was employed in the maintenance department of Harodite Finishing Co., until his retirement seven years ago and was long active in city sporting events. He was a boxer locally and was an avid hunter and fisherman.
