Joseph Albert Medeiros of 33 Southway St. (Rocky Knoll Estates), dog officer for the city of Taunton for several years, died Tuesday afternoon at Morton Hospital following a long illness. He was 68.

Born in St. Michael, Azores, he was a son of the late Manuel A. and Georgianna (Furtado) Medeiros and the husband of the late Olga L. (Dias) Medeiros.
