## Albert Morgado, well-known barber

**MATTAPOISETT** — Albert "Al the Barber" Morgado, 65, who owned and operated his Church Street shop for more than 30 years, died unexpectedly at home yesterday. He was the husband of J. Rose (Hart) Bisaillon Morgado and lived at 3 Dexter Lane.

A lifelong Mattapoisett resident, Mr. Morgado told The Standard-Times in 1979 that he learned to cut hair during World War II.

"Decided I liked it and here I stayed," he said, adding that his was a barber — not a beauty — shop. "None of that fancy stuff," he said.

Mr. Morgado's shop also was a popular gathering spot for a "gang of old guys" he affectionately called the "PL Club — Professional Loafers Club." They visited frequently to exchange news while Mr. Morgado went to work with his clippers.

A sign on his shop wall summed it up: "Welcome to Al's Barbershop. There are no strangers here. Only friends you haven't met."

Mr. Morgado was a communicant of St. Anthony Church. He was a Navy veteran of World War II and was a member of the American Legion of Mattapoisett.
