### Virginio Pacheco-Vieira

PORTSMOUTH — Virginio "Vee" Pacheco-Vieira, 82, formerly of Narragansett Avenue, a garden farmer many years before retiring, died Friday at St. Anne's Hospital, Fall River. He was the husband of M. Sophie Pacheco-Vieira.

Born in St. Michael, the Azores, a son of the late Joseph and Jacqueline (Vieira) Pacheco, he lived in Portsmouth since 1925. He came to this country in 1920 and settled in Bristol.

He worked 15 years in the R.I. Department of Public Works, retiring in 1967. He was a communicant of St. Anthony's Church.
