

Brockton Man Killed In Moped-Car Crash

MIDDLEBORO — A 66-year-old Middleboro native died yesterday of injuries he received Monday in a collision between a moped he was operating and an automobile.

Albert E. Silva, of 34 Courtland Street, died at Cardinal Cushing Hospital, Brockton. He was the husband of Rhoda L. (Nickerson) Silva.

Police report Silva's moped was involved in a collision with a car at the four-street in-

tersection near Park and Frank streets.

Two town police officers, trained as emergency medical technicians, responded to the accident and reported Silva showed vital signs upon arrival at St. Lukes Hospital. He was immediately taken by ambulance to Cardinal Cushing.

Silva was born in Middleboro, the son of the late Antone and Frances (Mendosa) Silva.

He worked as a domestic aide at St. Lukes state hospital in Lakeville and was a member of the Independent Order of Redmen and the Mitchell Memorial Club.

Survivors, besides his wife, include a son, Albert E., Jr., of Middleboro; three daughters, Mrs. Susan Sinnott, Mrs. Colleen Oliveira and Mary Silva, all of Middleboro; a brother, Joseph T. of Middleboro; a granddaughter and several nieces and nephews.
