Manuel "Cheese" Silveira, 69, of 265 Longmeadow Road, a retired truck driver for the city's Department of Public Works, died suddenly this morning at his home. He was the husband of Mary (Ferreira) Silveira.

Medical Examiner Dr. William H. Bennett Jr. ruled the death due to natural causes.

Born in Taunton, son of the late Joseph and Mary (Paiva) Silveira, he resided in this city all his life. He worked for the DPW until his retirement in 1976.
