FALL RIVER, Mass. — John M. Taveira, 90, of 126 Brown St., president of the Taveira Beef & Provision Co. which he founded in 1950, died at home yesterday. He was the husband of the late Caroline (Lowe) Taveira.

Born in Ponta Delgada, St. Michael, the Azores, he was a son of the late Joao Moniz Taveira and Maria de Carmo.

Mr. Taveira came to this country in 1909 and worked for several area meat-packing houses, including the Cudahy, Farrisey and Wilson Companies before starting his business.
